Support SB 957: Temporary Visitor Driver's Licenses for Immigrants

Illinois **Senate Bill 957** will give Temporary Visitor Driver's Licenses to undocumented immigrants living in the state. These licenses can only be used for driving, and not for identification.

Our Illinois bishops support these licenses as a way to keep immigrant families together. Too many immigrant parents are separated from their children when they are stopped for a minor traffic violation. Without a license, they are often taken to deportation centers.

The Illinois Senate has passed the legislation, and the Illinois House of Representatives is scheduled to vote on it during the first week of January. **Go to www.ilcatholic.org for more information.**
