Thank you for participating in the effort to promote our Illinois Catholic Advocacy Network (I-CAN).

The launch of I-CAN is the Illinois bishops' contribution to the USCCB's "Fortnight for Freedom," set for June 21-July 4. Cardinal George of Chicago and the other bishops from the dioceses of Belleville, Joliet, Peoria, Rockford and Springfield are encouraging pastors to ask parishioners to fill out the enclosed pew cards during the "Fortnight for Freedom." CCI is asking for parishioners' email address so we can keep them updated on state and federal issues affecting the Church, such as the HHS mandate. We ask for their home address so we know which legislative district they live in.

Enclosed are 300 pew cards, shrink-wrapped in groups of 100. During pilot projects of sign-up efforts for I-CAN, pastors who were enthusiastic about the program garnered a 30 percent response rate from Mass attendees.
